Guidelines for Authors:

The length of the paper should be between 8 and 10 pages, in Serbian or English language, written in accordance with the following guidelines:

Abstract: 10 pt, 100-250 words

Key words: 10 pt, up to 5 words

Summary: 11 pt, in English, 400-500 words, at the end of the text, after the references

File format: MS Word 2007 and older versions (*.docx; *.doc)

Font: Times New Roman

Page format: A4 (210×297mm)

Line spacing: single

Margins: left 3cm, right 2,5cm, top 2,5cm, bottom 2,5cm

Title of the paper: 14 pt, bold, alignment centered, capital letters

Author's name: 11 pt, alignment centered; in case of co-authorship, one author should be underlined as presenter.

Institutions and E-mail addresses: *11 pt, italic, alignment centred*

Text: 11 pt, in Latin alphabet, alignment justified, titles of chapters should be written using capital letters, without numeration

References: 11 pt, listed in alphabetical order, according to APA Citation Style

Picture title: *11 pt, italic, centered below a picture*

Table title: *11 pt, italic, centered above a table*

References in the text: footnote, bottom of page
